XRAY STANDING PELVIS

TECHNIQUE: A single view of the pelvis was submitted.

<u>FINDINGS</u>: There is no fracture identified. There is pelvic tilt identified in the right iliac crest lying above that of the left by a measurement of 1.7 cm. At the level of the inferior rami there is discrepancy measuring 6 - 7 mm with the right side lying above that of the left. The acetabular roofs demonstrate a discrepancy of 8 mm with the left side being below that of the right. The right greater trochanter lies above that of the left by 9 mm. At the lesser trochanters the discrepancy is 7 mm.

## IMPRESSION:

PELVIC TILT WITH THE RIGHT SIDE LYING ABOVE THAT OF THE LEFT. DISCREPANCY IS MAXIMALLY AT THE LEVEL OF THE ILIAC CREST AT 17 MM. HOWEVER, AT THE LEVEL OF THE HIPS THERE IS A DISCREPANCY BETWEEN 6 AND 8 MM, AS DESCRIBED ABOVE. THE RIGHT SIDE IS ELEVATED ABOVE THAT OF THE LEFT. NO ACUTE OSSEOUS ABNORMALITY IS IDENTIFIED.
